AB: "The present progressive"

Mit dem **present progressive** drückst du aus, dass etwas gerade jetzt in diesem Moment passiert! Meist gibt es Signalwörter, die darauf hinweisen. Signalwörter sind zum Beispiel:

right now, now, at the moment, today

Das **present progressive** wird so gebildet:

Eine Form von **be**
(am, is, are)

+

verb

+

ing

Examples:

I'm swimming in the water.

(to swim → **swimming**)

You're riding a blue bike.

(to ride → **riding**) *

He's / she's / it's standing on the floor.

(to stand → **standing**)

We're playing football right now.

(the play → **playing**)

You're singing a song at the moment.

(to sing → **singing**)

They're buying a new car today.

(to buy → **buying**)

* Endet ein Verb auf "e", dann wird es beim **present progressive** weg gelassen!

Mr Bossman is washing the car.

Flip and Flap are buying a present for Sam.
