Wichtig: a) 1. = first = 1st / 2. = second = 2nd / 3. = third = 3rd

21 = twenty-first = 21st / 22 = twenty-second = 22nd / etc.

b) 4 = fourth = 4th / 6. = sixth = 6th / 7. = seventh = 7th / etc.

c) **Vorsicht bei unregelmäßigen Schreibweisen!**

five = fifth / nine = ninth / twelve = twelfth / twenty = twentieth ...
