

REVISION: The simple present

Wie war das nochmal mit dem *simple present*?

Das *simple present* ist die einfache Form der *Gegenwart*. Im Deutschen benutzen wir um über die *Gegenwart* zu sprechen das Präsens, im Englischen ist es das *simple present*.

Wie bilde ich das *simple present*?

Bei positiven Aussagesätzen: I/You/We/They: verb (run/ride/see/ ...)

He/She/It: verb + **s** (runs/ rides/ sees/ ...)

Bei negative Aussagesätzen: I/You/We/They: **don't** + verb (don't run/ ...)

He/She/It: **doesn't** + verb (doesn't run)

8. Sam (like) tennis, but she (not like) computers.

2) A computer virus

1. often - go dancing - I

I often go dancing.

2. sometimes - tennis. - plays - My brother

3. Sports TV. - My dad - watches - always

4. never - sport. - My cousin - does

5. usually - goes swimming - Our class - on Friday.

6. riding. - goes - never - My mum.

7. She - always - in the morning. - walks

8. watch - school matches. - always - Tom and I

9. doesn't usually - play - My sister - hockey.

10. don't - We - often - play - football at school.
